

dg102 White Loch of Myrton from Back Bay

Port William to Sorbie Road

Fairly level walk to an ancient stone circle

S Go N from the car park back along the road to reach the Gavin Maxwell Memorial. Leave the road and go left on a clear path to reach A747 at Clarksburn Bridge. Go NW (left) and follow the road into Monreith. Just before the A747 bends sharp left go N on a minor road. Pass to the left of Monreith Village Hall before continuing N on a hedged track to reach a crossing track. (3¹/₂ km)

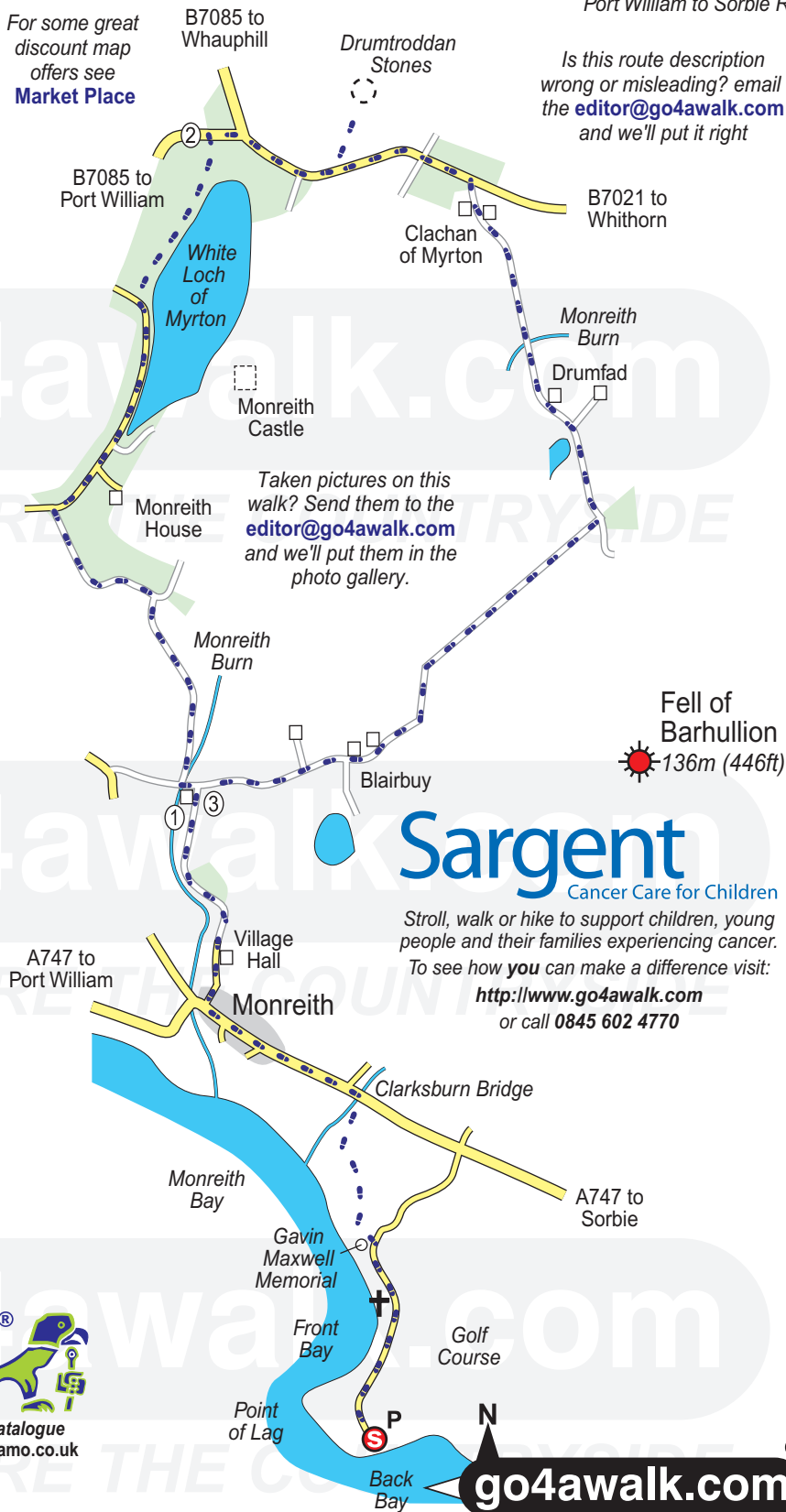
① Go W (left) to cross Monreith Burn and then immediately N through several gates (we've had reports that these are sometimes locked - so you might have to climb over them) and then woods to reach another crossing track. Go W (left) again and follow a track as it bears NW and N to a road. Go NE (right) and follow the road past Monreith House to reach White Loch of Myrton. When the track bears NW away from the loch continue N on a waymarked path. Go left at a fork and continue N to reach a road (B7021). (2¹/₂ km)

② Go SE (right) on the road for 350m to reach a gate on your left. If you go N through the gate, Drumtroddan Stones are in the next field. Retrace your steps back to the road. Continue NE on the road for a further 350m before going SE on a track. Follow the track S past Clachan of Myrton and Drumfad before turning sharp SW near a wood. Continue SW following the track through Blairbuy before bearing W to reach the outward route. (4¹/₂ km)

③ Retrace your steps back to the start. (3¹/₂ km)

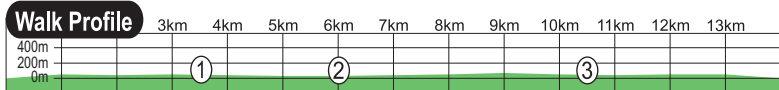
